Our Week of Learning

Reading - This week we began our 4th theme, Amazing Animals. Our feature story was Officer Buckle and Gloria. This is a funny story that showed the importance of teamwork and we were able to work with Cause and Effect. Have your child tell you why Gloria was such an amazing animal.

Word Study- Our focus this week was on the on the R-Controlled (AR) sound, like in hair, flare, and bear. Many children were able to connect this sound with the long a sound as well. If you notice the r-controlled (ar) sound while reading with your child, make sure to point it out.

Math - This week we finished up Chapter 6 on 3-digit subtraction and addition. We reviewed this skill for a couple of days and then we took our Chapter 6 test. Many errors are happening because of computation mistakes. Please continue to work on those flashcards at home if needed! If you would like a set, please let me know and I will send one home. Next week we will begin Chapter 7 on Time and Money.

Writing - We continue to work through the Opinion writing process. This week we talked about using the illustrations to help us form an opinion about a book we are reading. We discussed how you can choose to write your opinion about a character, a favorite part, or the illustrations.

Science - We continue to make observations of our caterpillars and milkweed bugs. We notice they are getting bigger, caterpillars are molting, and there is silk in the cup. See if your child can tell you how the silk got there.
