Our Week of Learning

Reading - This week we read <u>Ants.</u> This is a nonfiction story where the kids learned many interesting facts about ants. Have your child tell you about two different ants about which they learned something new. We talked about many text features that can be found in nonfiction books such as maps, diagrams, headings, labels, captions, glossaries, and indexes.

Word Study- Our focus this week was on the OI/OY sound, like in coin and toy. This chunk was a little bit easier since we found a pattern that was true MOST, but not ALL, of the time. We discovered that most of the time the -oi comes in the middle of words and the -oy usually comes at the ends of words, except for words like oyster, royal, and loyal. Make sure to listen for these sounds as your child is reading to you this week.

Math - This week we started Chapter 7 on Money & Time. They are identifying pennies, nickels, dimes, and quarters and their values. Having your child practice at home by giving your child a handful of 5-10 coins and asking them to order the coins from greatest to least (in terms of value) and asking what the total is.


Writing - We are still working on using characters, settings, illustrations, and events that happen in our books to develop our opinions. This week we discussed and practiced retelling part of the book to help our readers understand the reasons for our opinions. Looking back at the book helps us to find those areas that may need clarification, and also helps us find more reasons to support our opinions.
