Our Week of Learning

Reading - This week we read a story called Jamaica Louise James. Throughout the story we made inferences about what was happening. For further practice with inferring, we read two books where the children had to look at the cover, think about what clues might be there to help us know what the story might be about. Next week the children will be reading nonfiction books and writing responses to questions about these books. Our word study this week focused on the bossy "r" sound using "o". (corn, four, poor, shore). Next up is the bossy "r" sound using e, i, and u (teacher, first, turn).

Math - The children were excited to begin working on 3-digit addition. We are using all the strategies we learned with 2-digit addition. We always begin by adding the ones column first, regroup if necessary, then do the tens column, and finally the hundreds. You will find a midchapter review sheet in his/her homework folder to practice this skill. To help know the basic subtraction facts, the children are doing a short, timed sheet. They are working to improve their scores each day.

Science

We have watched our brassica plants go through the whole life cycle. The children began this investigation by planting brassica seeds and this week they "harvested" seeds from the adult plant. We continue to observe our mealworms form pupa, and later darkling beetles emerge from the pupa. Today, we received new eggs. Have your child describe them to you. We are all anxious to see what emerges when the eggs hatch!
