## Our Week of Learning

**Reading** - Our reading strategy focus for this week was evaluating a story. As a class we read the nonfiction story Exploring Parks with Ranger Dockett. We also worked on fact and opinion while reading this story.

**Word Study** - This week we studied open-syllable words like we, go, my, label and polite. We noticed that these one syllable words end with a long vowel sound. If they are two syllable words ask your student where you divide the word into syllables to hear the long vowel sound.

**Math** - We finished up chapter 2 on place value in 3 digit numbers. We also worked on comparing numbers in this chapter using the vocabulary words less than, greater than and equal to. We took our chapter 2 test and will begin chapter 3 next week.

**Writing** - We continue to work on our small moment writing. This week we talked about adding transition words into our writing to tell the sequence of events in a story. We used words such as first, next, then, last, after that, finally, and a few more. We also talked about how important it is to use mentor texts to help us write. We tried to think of books we've read that remind us of something in our lives that we can connect to in our own writing.

**Science** - This week our investigation focused on mixing liquids with liquids. We found out that some liquid mixtures can be reversed (it can be separated into two separate liquids) but most liquids stay mixed. We will finish our Solids and Liquids unit next week.
