Our Week of Learning

Reading - This week we read a new genre, Biographies. Ask your child to tell you what are the characteristics of a biography. In their anthologies, the children read short biographies about three individuals, Ellen Ochoa, Theodore Roosevelt and Wilma Rudolph. Have your child tell you which individual they found most interesting and their reasons for thinking that way (opinion).

Word Study- Our focus this week was on variant vowel /o/. It's the sound you hear in words like saw, brought, and lawn. Have your child listen for these sounds and point them out to you as they are doing their daily read aloud to you:)

Math - How many inches are in a foot? How many feet are in a yard? What is the best unit to use when finding the distance between Solon and Iowa City? Students have been measuring away as we study the US Customary System of Measurement. We have measured in different units, estimated, and decided on the best tools for measuring.

Writing - This week students completed the On-Demand Writing Assessment for reporting student learning. S/He needed to include everything s/he has been practicing when writing their opinions. In my opinion you will be very impressed with your child shares his/her writing with you at our Parent/Student/Teacher conference.

Science - Today we said good-bye to the last of our classroom "pets". We will begin our next science unit, Pebbles, Sand and Silt.
